



For your safety and benefit these reasonable rules will be expected and followed:

- A**ttitude ~ Christian conduct and character is expected at all times.
- T**ime ~ You will be expected to follow the schedule.
- M**issing ~ You will not be permitted to leave the grounds except for scheduled excursions.
- O**n & Off ~ Your clothing should be of a modest nature. The standards of the world are not the standards of Lake Aurora. This especially includes swimsuits. If clothing is inappropriate or immodest, you may be asked to change.
- S**ickness ~ All sickness and accidents must be reported to your counselor or camp nurse promptly. Lake Aurora has a modest accident insurance policy covering each camper.
- P**romotion ~ Shirts and clothing promoting alcohol or tobacco products, suggestive statements, grotesque scenes, or other graphics not consistent with a Christian environment may not be worn or displayed. This will include bumper stickers & signs on vehicles.
- H**ealthy ~ Tobacco, alcoholic beverages, and illegal items & other such products are not permitted.
- E**ducation & Electronics ~ To maximize the camp experience ----Smart devices, music/dvd, gaming devices/players, radios, Tablets/lpads, etc. **should not be** brought.
- R**ights ~ While at camp your rights will be determined by The Golden Rule of Christ. Christianity is and always has been a religion that was based on one "denying one's self". This principle will affect what you say, what you do, what is expected of you, & what you can expect from others.
- E**mergency ~ Parents/Guardians will be notified of any emergency. Cell phones are not permitted for campers.

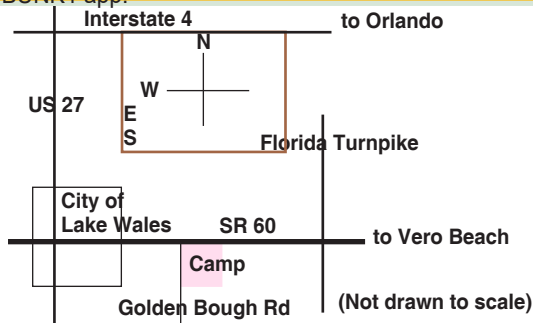
Please Note:

- ★ Aquatics campers may use cash or place money in a store/canteen card account.
- ★ Group Camp Photos can be ordered on original registration card or Canteen envelope. *6 for an 8x10.
- ★ Once you arrive on the grounds by means of transportation approved by your parents, you will be expected to remain on the grounds (except for official reasons) until you leave by the means of transportation approved by your parents.
- ★ We are unable to house and care for campers wanting to stay over the weekend when they are attending two consecutive programs. Please arrange to be picked up at the close of each program.

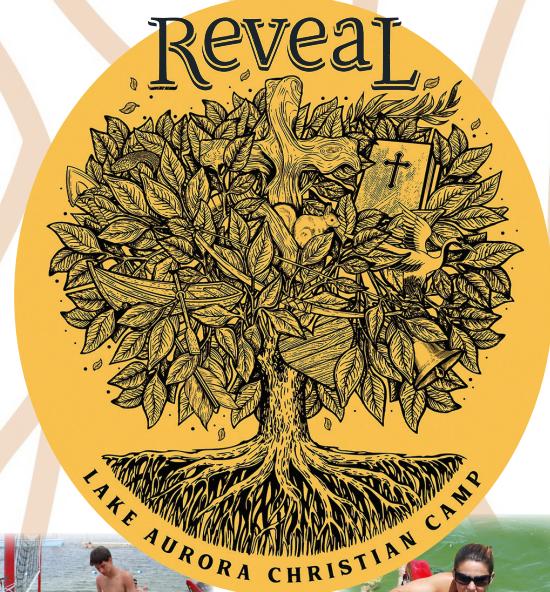

Leadership Development Aquatics Preparing for Red Cross Certification

Information Summer 2023

Online Blended Learning - Must be completed by midnight Monday

Blended learning combines online learning with an in-person skills session where you will practice skills and demonstrate competency. Your fee covers the Red Cross course expense.

A voucher link will be sent to active registrations.

If you do not already have a Red Cross account, you will need to create one – click the “New User” link and complete the information for the account – please make note of your username and password for future access to the online content.

Complete all online classes on the same computer device.

Upon Arrival...

In your hand please have:

- Any medication in ORIGINAL containers!
- Completion printout of your online classes from Red Cross Blended Learning

* Please go directly to the Ministry Center (office) for check in and housing assignments. Aquatics camp checks in on TUESDAY. All check in procedures will take place in the same location... the office.

* Each camper will have their temperature taken & answer recent medical history questions prior to selecting beds. (No one with a temp of 100.4° or higher will be admitted into camp. - Please self screen the days prior and DO NOT come to camp SICK!)

* Each camper must be processed through Housing Assignments BEFORE entering dorm.

Please remember...

All medication must be turned in to the camp nurse after housing assignment is confirmed. (Original containers required - “daily organization system” must be supported with original Rx)

What to Bring for Aquatics

- Bible
- Pen/Pencil
- Swimsuits***
- Towel***
- Hat
- Sunglasses
- Insect Repellent
- Water bottle with name
- Waterproof Sunscreen (minimum SPF 15+)
- Light jacket
- Swimming Goggles
- Mask, Snorkel, Fins (search/rescue)
- Sandals or Beach shoes
- Tennis Shoes, Shorts, Shirts
- Bed sheets or sleeping bag
- Alarm clock
- Warm ups*

*** You are encouraged to bring at least two.

* Optional - sometimes evenings have cool weather



Aquatic campers need to be checked in and at the waterfront by 4:30 pm. on Tuesday



One specific focus of Aquatics camp is learning skills which MAY enable the participant to receive a Lifeguard certificate from the American Red Cross. Each participant must be able to swim 550 yards. (200 crawl stroke, 200 breast stroke, 150 combination of either strokes.) This course will also include American Red Cross First Aid and Safety and CPR for the Professional Rescuer.

Please Note...

Please refer to “rules”, for things not to bring with you. No cell phone use while in the program.



Clothing Suggestions

Bring items you don't mind getting dirty. In preparing for the lifeguard course, it is helpful to have several swim suits that stay secure and will be easy to make rescues in without being self-conscious.

Please remember you are in a leadership role. Your example is very important, therefore, consider your clothing choices carefully. Your clothing cannot and should not be a distraction.

Pick Up...

11 am on Saturday

Enter campus at 1st entrance off Golden Bough (main entrance) and proceed to Hillside housing. Each driver will receive a “camper check out card”. Please complete with names of campers riding in vehicle and turn in to camp staff upon departure.



Spending Money - Canteen/Store Card

Aquatic campers may use cash or may purchase Store Card credit. Debits may be purchased on the canteen/ bank envelope or online through the Registration Page. The “Store card” can be used as cash in any area of our programs.
